SDRCC to Host Regional Seminar of the Court of Arbitration for Sport

Montréal (Québec) - The Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC) is proud to announce that a Regional Seminar of the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) will take place in Vancouver, British Columbia, on February 11, 2016.

This special occasion will mark the first time that a CAS event will be held in either Canada or in the United States, dating to its foundation in 1984. "The creation of the SDRCC Dispute Resolution Secretariat in 2003 was very much inspired by the sport arbitration system that CAS had already established, and it is therefore a true honour for the SDRCC to partner with CAS for the organization of this event", said David de Vlieger, Chairman of the SDRCC Board.

The CAS Regional Seminar will exceptionally replace the public component of the SDRCC Annual Mediator and Arbitrator Conference and will be open for general registration, under the theme "Pursuing Excellence in Sport Dispute Resolution".
