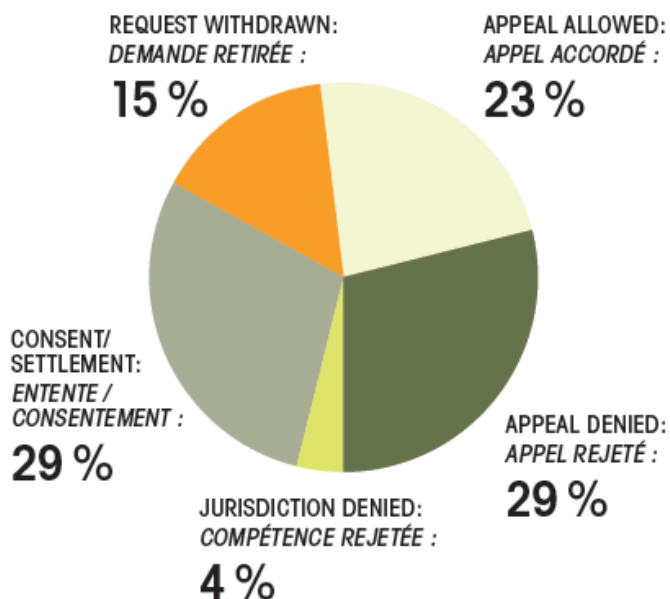

### Outcomes in Ordinary Disputes



### ORDINARY TRIBUNAL

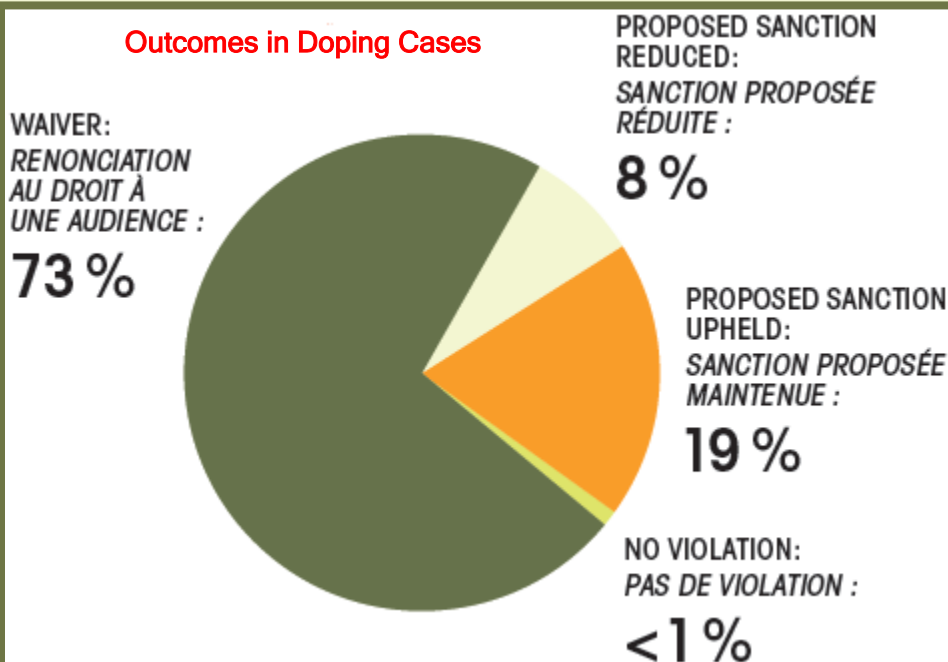
**Appeal Allowed/Denied:** An Arbitrator rendered an award in favor/against the Claimant.

**Consent/Settlement:** Parties reached a mutually agreed upon solution without the need for an arbitration hearing.

**Appeal Withdrawn:** The Claimants rescinded their appeal voluntarily; in some cases because parties reached a settlement independently from the SDRCC process.

**Jurisdiction Denied:** When appeals are filed with the SDRCC without the prerequisite conditions being met, an arbitrator may declare that the SDRCC does not have jurisdiction to hear those cases.

### Outcomes in Doping Cases



### DOPING CASES

**Sanctions:** The duration of an ineligibility period varies depending on the nature of the violation. It is determined by an Arbitrator following a hearing, depending on the circumstances of each case.

**Waiver:** When persons accused of doping violations waive their right to a hearing and accept the sanction proposed by the CCES.

**No Violation:** When the Arbitrator finds that the person was not in violation of the anti-doping rules.
